CRICOS Registration

To provide courses to full fee paying overseas students, the School must be registered on CRICOS. As a school provider, Kambala must be re-registered on CRICOS at least every five years.

There is a two-stage approval process for registration and re-registration.

First, the School is required to apply for approval through its DSA. The DSA will ensure the School's compliance with the requirements for the delivery of courses to full fee paying overseas students under the ESOS Framework, and compliance with the jurisdiction's own set of guidelines, if applicable. Once the DSA has approved the School's registration, the DSA then makes a recommendation to the Cth DET that the School be included on CRICOS.

Upon approval, the provider will be allocated a CRICOS number, which is retained on CRICOS.

Kambala ensures that our CRICOS registration number is clearly displayed on all marketing and information materials relating to full fee paying overseas students, and is also displayed on our public website.

Our CRICOS registration is due for renewal at 01/12/2021.

Part 7A of the Education Act 1990 (NSW) authorises NESAs as the DSA responsible for approving schools to be registered on CRICOS. NESAs have the power to suspend, cancel or amend its approval of the School's CRICOS registration and make recommendations to the Cth DET about the School's registration.

NESA has issued its own **Guidelines for Approved School Providers Delivering Courses to Overseas Students**, which outline how schools must comply with the ESOS Framework in order to be approved by NESA. Where relevant, references to the NESA Guidelines are included throughout this Program and in the policies and procedures that evidence our compliance with the requirements of the ESOS Framework.
